Your Calls Today Can Save Lives. Phone is Power: Please Call Now.

Yesterday one mosque, a Muslim school and a graveyard were destroyed close to Yangon, the largest city of Burma.

As always it starts with a rumor. The extremist Buddhists attack a mosque and then massive attacks on all Muslims follow while the police and military watches silently.

At least 4 times your phone calls to the President Obama, Secretary Kerry, and the U.S. Ambassador to Burma Scot Marciel have forced the military to intervene to fend off the extremists attacks.

Usually we appeal for funds at this time but it is more important that you exercise your voice. Please call. Save lives.

In 10 minutes we can accomplish miracles.

What happened:

- Yesterday, June 23, 2016 afternoon extremist Buddhist mob ransacked a mosque in Thuye Tha Mein village in Bago province in central Myanmar forcing Muslims to flee for their lives. Also mosque was destroyed along with a Muslim school and a cemetery.
- These Muslims are not Rohingyas, but Burmese Muslims. Attacks on non-Rohingya Muslims are increasing.

One Minute Action:

- If you have one minute please contact the State Department asking them to get the US ambassador in Burma to visit the site which is just few miles from Yangon.
- Take just 10 minutes to contact the White House, State Department, the US Ambassador and the Burmese ambassador to the USA.

Talking Points:

- Tell them in the past their visit to the areas of attack has brought peace to the region.
- Ask them to call their counter-part in Burma and appeal to them to stop these attacks.
- If the new "democratic" government is allowed to ignore this violence the same way the past government has it will become a pattern.
